

Safety information

Please read the safety instructions carefully before using the product for the first time and keep the instructions for future reference.

- 1. Warning: This product includes lithium polymer batteries.
- 2. Warning: Adult supervision required. Keep camera away from toddlers under 3 years old and pets to avoid chewing and swallowing. Discard broken buttons or parts at once.
- 3. Product operating and storage temperature is from 0 degree Celsius to 40 degree Celsius. Under and over this temperature might affect the function.
- 4. Never open the product other then for changing print paper rolls. Touching the inside electrics can cause electric shock. Repairs or service should only be performed by qualified personnel.
- 5. Do not expose to heat, water, moisture, direct sunlight!
- 6. The unit is not waterproof. If water or foreign objects enter the unit, it may result in fire or electric shock. If water or a foreign object enters the unit, stop use immediately.
- 7. Only charge with supplied USB cable.
- 8. Do not use non-original accessories together with the product as this can make the product functionality abnormal.

PREPARATION

1.Power

-Power on: Press and hold the power button to turn on the camera

-Power off: Press and hold the power button turn off the camera.

2.SD Card

*Note:

- -Make sure the device is powered off before inserting or replacing the Micro SD card.
- -Make sure the Micro SD card is facing the correct direction when inserting it.
- -Do not force the card in, as this may damage the card or the device. If the card does not fit easily, check that the card is facing the correct position.
- -When the capacity of the memory card is higher than 32GB, you need to format the memory card on the camera before using it (the format MUST be FAT32).

How to format micro SD cards over 32 GB on the camera:

-Press button to select the settings icon,press button to enter setting mode.

-Press button to select Fromat press button to enter format micro SD cards, as shown below:



-Press button to select "Execute",press button to confirm.

-The screen will appear: "Please Wait..", as shown below:

-When the "Please Wait..." prompt disappears from the screen, the SD card has been formatted successfully.




- -Support up to 128GB(FAT32), to remove or replace the card with a new one,proceed as follows:
- -To remove the memory card, gently press the card until you hear a "click" and then remove the card.
- -Reinstall or replace the card. Insert the card (or any new Micro SD card) into the Micro SD card slot with the contacts facing the displayside.



3.Battery charging

*Note: Recommended for adults.

- Plug the supplied TYPE-C USB cable (small end) into the camera's USB port.
- Plug the large end of the TYPE-C USB cable into your computer or a standard USB power outlet adapter.
- Please charge your camera before using it. It takes approximately 2 hours to fully charge the battery.
- When the battery level is low, a message will appear on the screen: Low Battery.



- After successful connection, the charging indicator lights up red.
- When the battery is fully charged, Charging indicator red off.
- Once the battery is fully charged, unplug the charger from the power outlet, then unplug the camera from the charger cable.

Battery level indication, please refer to the illustration:



OPERATION

1.Photo mode

*Note:

The Camera supports printing without SD card.Adjust the "Print Density" in the settings menu to adjust the printing effect, different kind of printing paper will have different printing effect.

-Short press button to select photo icon, press button to enter photo mode.



- -Short press the button to take a picture.
- -In photo mode, press the button briefly to turn on /off the flash function.

The icon appears at the top of the screen when the flash is on.

- -In the photo mode, press the button to switch printing on/off.
- If the print function is on,the print icon will appear at the top of the screen,the photo will be printed instantly when the photo is taken.
- -In the photo mode, short press button to switch different photo frames and special effects;
- -Long press button to set the zoom function.
- -Long press the button to switch front and rear lens.
- -Press button to exit photo mode and enter the main interface.

2.Video mode

-Short press to Select video icon, press button to enter the video mode.



- -Short press button to start recording, short press button again to stop recording.
- -Long press the ow button to switch front and rear lens.
- -Press Dutton to exit video mode and enter the main interface

3.Playback

-Short press button to select the playback icon, press button to enter the playback mode. Or press button to enter playback mode.



- -Short press 00 button to select previous or next photo/video
- -Press ok button to play/pause the video.



-In playback mode, press button to delete photos/videos.

press button to confirm.



- -Printing photos in playback mode
- ①Press the buttons consecutively functions in the following order:greyscale printing, dot matrix printing, switching off the print function.
- ②Press the ○○ button to select a photo.
- ③Press the ok button to print the photo.
- 4 Press button to exit browsing mode and enter the maininterface.
- *Note:
- -Video in playback mode cannot be printed.
- -When camera is low power, the photos cannot be printed.
- -Printing photo is not allowed when the camera is charging.
- -When there is no paper available, the screen will indicate: Paperless.
- -When the printer is overheating, the screen will prompt: high temperature and printing will be paused, wait a few minutes before using the printing function.

4.Setting

-Short press button to select setting mode, press button to enter the setting mode.



-In setting mode, you can set:

Photo Size:20M,12M,8M,5M,3M,2M,1M;

Video Resolution:1080P,720P,VGA;

Print Density:0,1,2,3,4: Loop recording:Off,On; Language:12 languages;

Time Stamp: Off,On;

Screen bright: 8,7,6,5,4,3,2,1;

LCD Off:Off,1Min,2Min,3Min;

Auto Off:Off,3Min,5Min;

Format; Date time; Sys. Reset; Version

-Short press to select setting item, press button to enter the sub-menu.short press button to select the setting item that needs to be changed,

Short press ok button to confirm the change.

-Short press button to exit the setting mode.

5.Game mode

-Short press button to select game icon,Press button to enter the game mode;

-There are 4 built-in games



-Short press button to select the game; press button to start.

-After selecting the game, press button to control the direction.

-Short press button to exit the game mode.

6.Music Mode

*Note:Music files in MP3 form at should be copied to the SD card first

Adult operation is suggested.

-Short press the button to select music mode, press button to enter the music mode.



-In the music mode

Short press button to select the previous song.

Short press button to select the next song.

Short press button to play/Pause music

Short press

○ button to increase the volume. Volume can be adjusted in 15 steps: 1~15.

Short press O button to decrease the volume.

7.Device Reset

*Note:

Adult operation is recommended.

There is a small hole on the right side of the SD port. If the device dies, insert a sharp object into the small hole to reset the device.

8.Insalling the Print Paper

1. Open the paper slot in the direction of the arrow



2. Insert the print paper correctly in the direction indicated by the sticker on the camera.



3. The first time you install the paper, you need to extend the paper beyond the print slot about 1cm; each time you tear off the printed photo without re-installing the paper



9.USB Mode

-No card connection machine will enter the PCCAM function, the machine is equipped with micro SD card will enter the U disk function.

Note:

When the camera is switched off and connected to a computer, the camera is in charging mode; only when the camera is power on and connected to a computer will the camera enter USB mode.
