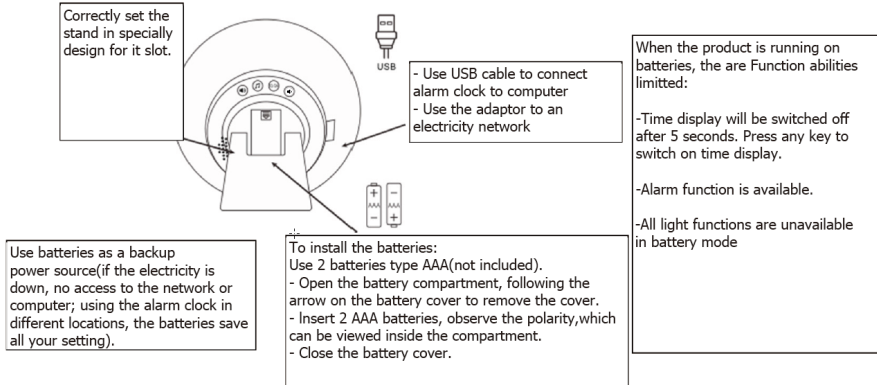

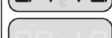

Sunrise light simulation


When the alarm time is set, the wake up light will switch on 30 minutes before the alarm time in low brightness and gradually increase the brightness. At the alarm time the brightness will be full. The natural sound will be played for 2 minutes at the alarm time.

During wake up alarm play




- Touch  button to snooze the alarm for 5 minutes. After 5 minutes the alarm will play again for 2 minutes. Press or touch any buttons except  to stop sound.
- Press and hold  to switch off wake up light.



Sunset light simulation



30 min before sunset time, the light is turned on with 100% brightness and then the brightness is reduced gradually and will turn off at sunset time.

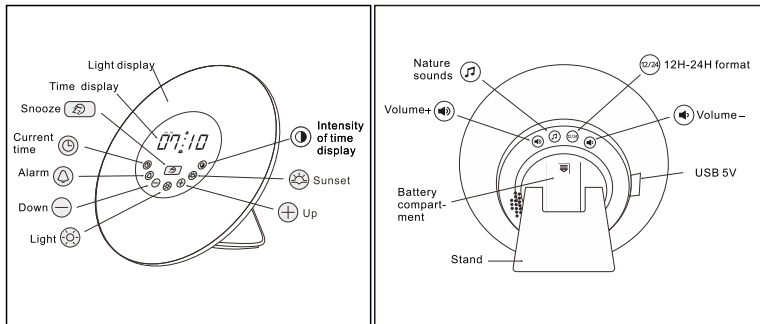
During sunset light is turned on you may: Press and hold  to turn off the light.
