### Charging the power bank

- 1. Fully charge the power bank before using at the first time.
- 2. Connect Type-C cable to the Type-C input jack of the device.
- 3. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source.
- 4. When all 3 LEDs are lit the power bank is fully charged.

# Using hand warmer

- 1. Press and hold the power button for 2 seconds to start heating mode.
- 2. The LEDs will be red in heating mode.
- 3. The hand warmer will be in high heat mode (48°C) to start, press the power button again for medium heat (40°C), press a third time for low heat (35°C).
- 4. To exit heating mode, double click the power button.
